## **CLEANING RECOMMENDATION FOR STAINLESS STEEL & HARDWARE PRODUCTS**

We recommend that any hardware product exposed to harsh environmental conditions, especially in external applications, is cleaned regularly. Please refer to our cleaning recommendation guide below as laid out by SASSDA.

Stainless Steel is one of the most durable metals available with its exceptional ability to resist stains, rust and corrosion. However, contrary to popular belief, even the finest alloy will suffer if not cared for. It is necessary that stainless steel products are regularly cleaned to resist negative effects from natural elements such as rain, wind and salt. Using a stainless steel cleaner or spray is the ideal prevention measure in this regard and is highly recommended.

Routine gentle cleansing will reward the owner with a product that retains its properties and appearance through many years.

The Southern African Stainless Steel Development Association (SASSDA) recommends as follows:-

### **ROUTINE CLEANING:**

The best method for cleaning Stainless Steel is quite simply a light soapy warm water solution using a mild detergent (such as SUNLIGHT LIQUID®), applied with a soft cloth or synthetic sponge.

Routine cleaning applied over several days will generally remove heavy soiling and staining.

### **DO's:**

- Routine gentle cleaning
- Household cleaners showing 'suitable for Stainless Steel'
- Repeated routine gentle cleaning rather than a single aggressive cleaning

### **DON'Ts:**

- Coarse abrasive powders
- Metallic scourers
- Silver or brass cleaners

### **OTHER HARDWARE**

Door rollers should be lubricated regularly (*and the sliding door track kept free from sand or grit to ensure the roller's optimum performance*).

Aluminium door handles should be wiped with a soft cloth on weekly basis.

For lock care we recommend spraying the internal mechanism of the lock where possible with a lubricant, like a dry silicone spray, every 3 months.
